

## ȘARBA 2 Șt.

Ripening period: Fourth (IV)

### Grape cluster:

- Size: medium, 220 – 260 g
- Shape: cylindro-conical
- Compactness: compact

### Berry:

- Size: medium, 2.3 – 2.6 g
- Shape: spherical
- Color: greenish-yellow
- Flesh: crunchy
- Aroma: specific
- Seeds: present



### Tolerance:

- Drought: good
- *Plasmopara viticola* (downy mildew): medium
- *Uncinula necator* (powdery mildew): medium
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### Maintainer:

INCDBH Ștefănești – Argeș

### Agrobiological and Technological Characterization:

Growth vigor is high.

### Fertility coefficients:

- Absolute: 1.30 – 1.40
- Relative: 0.8 – 1.0

### Productivity index:

- Absolute: 303 – 370
- Relative: 190 – 220

Sugar concentration in the must is about 228 g/L, with total acidity between 3.4 - 3.6 g/L H<sub>2</sub>SO<sub>4</sub>.

Average production per vine is fairly constant at about 3.6 kg, with an average yield per hectare around 16 tons.

### Zoning:

Recommended for cultivation in most vineyards across the country.

The 'Șarba 2 Șt.' clone stands out by:

- Large clusters and berries
- Yellow-golden color
- Strong and pleasant aroma
